

# VILLAGE OF SPRING GROVE

## SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLING PROGRAM 2009

### STANDARD COLLECTION (1X/week)

Spring Grove, in cooperation with Groot Industries is pleased to provide this condensed guide to solid waste and recycling services. Our program of refuse, recycling and yard waste collection is a result of our commitment to reducing the waste stream in order to conserve landfill space and preserve our natural resources. Groot Industries will continue to collect an unlimited volume of garbage, including one (1) bulk item per week, *on Tuesdays or Wednesdays, depending on your location. #### PROGRAMS AND COST

**Regular curbside pickup:** Residents place refuse and recycling at the curb utilizing the 95 gallon refuse cart that they have received from Groot. Residents will also place their recyclables out to the curb utilizing the 65 gallon cart that they received from Groot. Cost per month per unit for this service is **\$17.90**.

**Senior curbside pickup:** Seniors (head of household aged 65+) can place refuse and recycling at the curb in the 35 gallon cart that they have received from Groot. Seniors will also place their recyclables out to the curb in the 35 gallon recyclable cart that they have received from Groot. Cost for this service per unit, per month is **\$16.01**.

To receive the senior discount residents must be 65 years old or older. Residents will need to go to the Village Hall to receive the Village's approval. Residents will need to bring a copy of their State ID or Drivers License. The Village will notify Groot of its approval of the senior discount.

**Appliances:** White goods such as refrigerators, freezers, ovens, washers, window and central air conditioners, humidifiers, dehumidifiers, dryers, water heaters, water softeners, dishwashers, stoves, ranges, furnaces etc. require a special pick up as separate disposal is required by the state. There will be a one time fee of \$35.00 per item for collection and residents must call and schedule a pick up in advance.

**Yard Waste:** Yard waste is collected April 1 through November 30. Residents have two options for yard waste disposal they are as follows;

**1. Yard Waste Stickers:** Residents who have limited volumes of yard waste will have the option to purchase a sticker and place the sticker on a biodegradable yard waste bag. Stickers will be available to purchase for \$2.75 each at the following locations:

**2. Yard Waste Subscription Service:** Residents who generate higher volumes of yard waste will have the option to sign up for the subscription program. This program allows up to four biodegradable bags or containers of yard waste per week. Containers may not exceed 35 gallons, be clearly marked "yard waste only", and have lids removed when at the curb. During the period of April 1 - April 15 and October 15 - November 30, subscribing residents will be allowed to put out six bags/cans of yard waste per week. To receive this service residents must call Groot and subscribe for \$150.00 for the 2009 season. Tree limbs, branches or brush must be cut to no more than 4 feet in length, bundled no greater than 2 feet in diameter and placed in a biodegradable bag.

#### HOLIDAYS OBSERVED:

New Year's Day	Memorial Day
July 4th	Labor Day
Thanksgiving Day	Christmas Day

If the Holiday falls on a Sunday, Monday will be an off day with service delayed one day the remainder of the week.

**Bulk Item Disposal:** Residents are allowed to place out one piece of furniture or two cubic yards of construction material each week at no additional cost. Additional bulk items will be collected for \$15.00 per item.

**Oversized/Overweight Items:** Any single large or extra heavy item that requires us to schedule a special pick up to remove will require a one time fee of \$15.00 per item. Residents are required to call and schedule a pick up in advance. Examples of an oversized item are a large screen television, piano or any item that requires two people to lift.

**Construction Demolition Debris:** Residents are allowed two cubic yards a week at no additional charge/ all material must be cut to no more than 4 feet in length and no larger than 2 feet in diameter. All debris must be bagged or bundled not exceeding 50 pounds. We charge \$15.00 per additional cubic yard (3'x3'x3'), if pick up is done a day other than your normal service day there will be additional charge of \$30.00.

#### SINGLE-SORT RECYCLING PROGRAM

Recyclable materials are collected curbside on your primary day of service. Recyclable materials do not need to be separated. Recyclables are separated at an automated recycling plant.

*Before you toss it in the recycling bin . . .  
Please rinse all items to remove food residue.*

**Please Do NOT Place Garbage  
in Recycling Container.**

**You Do Not Have To Separate  
Recyclable Materials.**

Please combine the following recyclable materials in the recycling bin:

► **Glass, Metal**

- aluminum cans      metal cans
- steel cans          tin cans
- empty aerosol cans      foil and foil trays
- glass bottles and jars (clear, green, brown)

► **Plastics** (i.e. Pop Bottles, Milk Jugs)

As well as all containers labeled PETE #1, HDPE #2 and #3 thru #7

**NEWSPAPER AND MIXED PAPER**

- Newspaper
- Office Paper (Computer/Ledger)
- Junk Mail
- Chip Board (Cereal Boxes, etc.)
- Magazines
- Telephone Books
- Mixed Paper (White and colored)

**CARDBOARD**

- Cardboard boxes must be broken down, flattened and cut into a manageable size (2'x2'). Place these materials next to your other recyclables, or under your recycling bin.

**GENERAL BILLING INFORMATION:**

Billing for Village residents is generated on a post card format 4 times per year in advance of each service period. After 45 days, unpaid bills will be considered past due, and are subject to a 15% service charge per month.

**SERVICE TERMINATION PROCEDURES**

Please Note: A weekly collection of solid waste is **required** per village ordinance.

The Village of Spring Grove appreciates your cooperation in your efforts in making this expanded cost saving service a success.

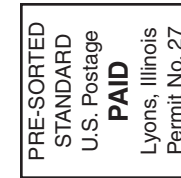
