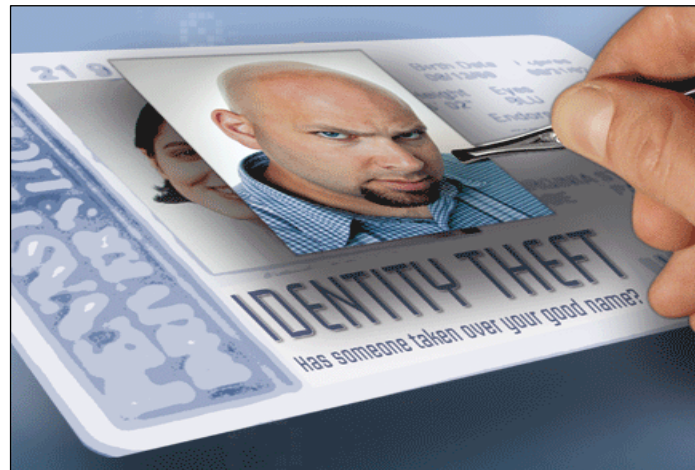


IDENTITY THEFT

IF YOUR IDENTITY HAS BEEN STOLEN

- Place a fraud alert on your credit reports and review your credit reports. Call the toll-free fraud number of anyone of the three major credit bureaus to place a fraud alert on your credit report. All three reports will be sent to you free of charge.

- Close any accounts that have been tampered with or opened fraudulently.
- File a report with your local police.
- File a complaint with the FTC (1-877-438-4338).

HOW IDENTITY THIEVES GET YOUR INFORMATION

- **THEY STEAL YOUR MAIL**
- **THEY COMPLETE A “CHANGE OF ADDRESS” FORM**
- **THEY RUMMAGE THROUGH YOUR TRASH**
- **THEY USE PERSONAL INFORMATION YOU SHARE ON THE INTERNET**
- **THEY POSE AS SOMEONE WHO HAS A LEGITIMATE RIGHT TO THE INFORMATION**
- **THEY FIND PERSONAL INFORMATION IN YOUR HOME**
- **THROUGH E-MAIL POSING AS A COMPANY YOU DO BUSINESS WITH**
