

**MEETING MINUTES OF THE PARKS COMMITTEE  
OF THE VILLAGE OF SPRING GROVE  
MAY 25, 2010**

A meeting of the Parks Committee was held this date at 6:20 p.m., at the Municipal Centre, 7401 Meyer Road, Chairperson McMahon presiding.

**Call to Order.** The following committee members were present: Chairperson Bob McMahon; Members Jim Anhalt, Del Houghton, Ron Kopke, Mike Lee and Pat Mazzanti - 6. Absent: Member Mark Eisenberg - 1. Also present for the Village were Tom Sanders, Police Chief and Executive Assistant; Laura Frumet, Deputy Clerk; Matt Wittum, Public Works Crew Leader and Trent Turner, Building and Zoning Officer.

**Approval of the April 27, 2010 Meeting Minutes.** Member Lee moved, seconded by Member Anhalt to approve the April 27, 2010 meeting minutes. Voice Vote: All Ayes. No Nays. Motion carried.

**New Business.**

**Discuss lowering of park rental fee for St. Scholastica Home School Group.** Mary Suchomski, resident of 917 Napa Trail and representing the St. Scholastic Home School Group, asked the committee to lower the rental fee of Horse Fair Park for them from \$100 to \$50 as they are a not-for-profit group. There are 50-70 families in the group with approximately 35 active families, half of which are village residents. They would like to rent the park on Monday afternoon, June 7<sup>th</sup> for an ice cream social. After some questioning it was determined that the group is not registered with the state as a not-for-profit. The committee concluded that the fee of \$100 covers the cost for the village to maintain the park and while they were sympathetic, they did not want to lower the fee. Ms. Suchomski said she understood and thanked the committee for their time.

**Unfinished Business.**

**Discuss Thelen Park Grand Opening.** All plans are in place for the grand opening. Chief Sanders said there should be no problem with closing the street for the parade as the parade is only two blocks long. Fire Chief Tobiasz said a fire department vehicle will be there from 9:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
