*Fee: \$5/hour with a minimum fee of \$10*

**Conditions of Approval:** *If the permittee does not own the premises from which the sale of liquor is made, a statement in writing executed and acknowledged by the owner of the premises shall be provided to the Liquor Commissioner stating the permittee has permission to occupy the premises at the dates and time of and for the purposes set forth in the application. At least one representative of the holder of a Special Liquor Permit issued by the Village who shall be on-site during the permitted time, is required to complete a Beverage Alcohol Sellers and Servers Education and Training (BASSET) and provide proof of compliance by attaching their certificate to the application.*

**Certificate of Insurance:** *You MUST provide a copy of your Certificate of Insurance, not the Policy Declaration. The Certificate of Insurance must show that you have liquor liability insurance and must include the following:*

- *The applicant name as the insured (e.g. if the applicant is a corporation, then the corporation's name must be listed; if the applicant is a sole proprietor, then the sole proprietor's name must be listed);*
- *The address of the location where liquor is being consumed and/or sold;*
- *The dates of coverage - must be concurrent with the license sought;*
- *A provision that states that the insurance coverage is in conformity to the requirements of the Dram Shop Act of Illinois and that said insurance is not cancelable unless at least thirty (30) days prior written notice is given to the Village of Spring Grove;*
- *The coverage limit for Liquor Liability of not less than \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence; and*
- *The Village of Spring Grove names as an additional insured.*
