**MEETING MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING  
OF THE VILLAGE OF SPRING GROVE  
JANUARY 4, 2022**

Council Chambers, Spring Grove, Illinois, January 4, 2022; a Regular Meeting of the Village Board was held this date at 6:00 p.m., at the Municipal Centre, 7401 Meyer Road; President Eisenberg presiding.

**Roll Call.** Roll call showed the following Board members present: President Mark Eisenberg; Trustees Jeff Letzter, Kelly Popelka, and Tom Sanders - 4. Absent: Trustees Mike Lee, Pat Mazzanti and Bob McMahon - 3. Also present for the Village were: Bob Walczak, Building and Zoning Officer, Mike Niedzwiecki, Police Chief; and Sandi Rusher, Village Clerk.

**President's Report.** President Eisenberg announced Trustee Popelka will be resigning on January 30, 2022 to step into an administrative role with the Village due to the upcoming retirement of Deputy Clerk Frumet and the future retirement of Clerk Rusher.

**Clerk's Report.** Residents can begin reserving Horse Fair Park on January 10. The Public Works and Safety Committee meetings scheduled for January 5 have been cancelled.

**Engineering Report.** The village engineer was excused from the meeting.

**Building and Zoning Report.** Ten new home and 395 miscellaneous permits were issued in 2021. LifeSpring Church did pave a temporary transition from their property to the newly poured entrance as required by January 5. There are still other building items that need to be completed so he will be issuing a 90 day temporary occupancy permit to complete.

**Police Department Report.** The department spent a significant amount of time seeking compliance in the Breezy Lawn and Wilmot Farms subdivision upon receiving complaints from residents regarding speeding. Officers issued one speeding ticket and seven warning tickets for not coming to a complete stop to residents.

The Board was made aware that the squad car ordered in April 2021 still has not been built and will be ordering another squad car soon.

Trustee Sanders stated that the Safety Committee will meet this month or next to discuss the Police Department's proposed salary step system so that it can be presented to the Board prior to budget approval.

**Committee Reports.** None.

**Public Discussion.** *President Eisenberg then opened the meeting up for discussion by the public.* Public comment was closed as there was no one in attendance who wished to speak.

**Consent Agenda.** Trustee Sanders moved, seconded by Trustee Letzter to accept the consent agenda. Roll call vote: Ayes: Eisenberg, Letzter, Popelka and Sanders – 4. Nays: None. Motion carried.
