Council Chambers, Spring Grove, Illinois, February 28, 2022; a special meeting of the Safety Committee was held this date at 9:13 a.m., at the Municipal Centre, 7401 Meyer Road; Chairman Tom Sanders presiding.

Call to Order. The following committee members were present: Chairman Tom Sanders and Members Mike Lee and Pat Mazzanti – 3. Absent: None. Also present for the Village were: Mike Niedzwiecki, Police Chief; Kelly Popelka, Deputy Clerk; and Sandi Rusher, Village Clerk.

Public Comment. *Chairman Sanders opened the meeting up for public comment.* Public comment was closed as no one from the public was present.

New Business

Consideration of the January 11, 2022 Special Safety Committee Meeting Minutes. Member Mazzanti moved, seconded by Chairman Sanders to approve the minutes as presented. On voice vote, the motion carried with Member Lee abstaining.

Discuss Police Department Staffing. Two part-time officers have been hired.


Review FYE 2023 Police Department Budget. It was questioned if the fuel line item should be increased as a result of gas prices on the rise and if the capital equipment and technology support line items should be increase due to repeatedly going over budget. Chief Niedzwiecki replied the technology support line item was increased \$1,500 over the previous years and explained it is costing more to outfit a new squad car due to equipment that is transferred from one to the other is nearing the end of its life. The committee direct the Police Chief to develop a vehicle and equipment replacement plan.

Four squad cars are being auctioned off and the money will be put back into the Police Department's Capital Fund.

Discuss Police Department Productivity. A plan has been put into place and productivity has increased in the last couple of month.

There being no further business, Member Mazzanti moved, seconded by Member Lee to adjourn the meeting at 9:26 a.m. On voice vote, the motion carried.
