Council Chambers, Spring Grove, Illinois, March 14, 2022; a meeting of the Community Engagement Committee was held this date at 6:02 p.m., at the Municipal Centre, 7401 Meyer Road; Chairman Mike Lee presiding.

Approval of the February 17, 2022 Meeting Minutes. Member Renz moved, seconded by Member White to approve the minutes as presented. On voice vote and all in favor, the motion carried.


Discuss having a Farmer's Market. Stephanie Essex from Repurposed Glitter was in attendance to talk about a farmer's market. Dates proposed were the 3rd Saturday of the month from May through October. Time would be from 8:00 a.m. to noon. Fee would be \$60 per vendor for the year and would not be prorated if someone wanted to join mid-season. Fee would go towards the cost of the portable toilets and any operating costs. Ms. Essex has been in contact with about 24 interested vendors. Ms. Essex will submit overall cost expectancy, initial sign up form and layout suggestions for Main Street Park.

Kick off to Summer - June 3 at Horse Fair Park. Discussed members chairing committees. Member Renz will chair advertising, Member Hernquist will chair entertainment and games, Member Horvath will chair food trucks, Member White will chair touch a truck and Chairperson Lee will chair volunteers. Village staff will chair beverages and any coordination needed with Public Works. Members agreed to forgo the rental of a carnival games booth for a luau themed bounce house. Village staff will put together potential layout of park for event.

Other Business. The next meeting of the committee will be on April 11, 2022 at 6:00 p.m.
