COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT COMMITTEE MEETING

APRIL 11, 2022

Council Chambers, Spring Grove, Illinois, April 11, 2022; a meeting of the Community Engagement Committee was held this date at 6:07 p.m., at the Municipal Centre, 7401 Meyer Road.

**Call to Order.** The following committee members were present: Members Jamie Horvath, Salli Renz, and Mike White – 3. Absent: Chairman Mike Lee and Member Helena Hernquist - 2. Also present for the Village were Kelly Popelka, Deputy Clerk, and Sandi Rusher, Village Clerk.

**Public Comment.** *Village Clerk Sandi Rusher opened the meeting up for public comment.* Public comment was closed as there was no one in attendance who wished to speak.

**Approval of the March 14, 2022 Meeting Minutes.** Member Renz moved, seconded by Member White to approve the minutes as presented. On voice vote and all in favor, the motion carried.


**Discuss Farmers Market.** Stephanie Essex from Repurposed Glitter reported on the vendors confirmed to date noting they have been offered a double space if spaces are available and wanted. Many who have reached out are unaware of Health Department regulations and have been directed to contact them as the Health Department conducts inspections. It was agreed to limit vendors to homemade items and seek vendors outside of our community as local vendors have been given an opportunity to register. Village will put something in the newsletter for booth availability. Committee members will each take a date to help with Farmers market setup, Member Horvath volunteered for August, Member White volunteered for October and Clerk Popelka volunteered for May. A Kris Kringle market was proposed to take place on December 3<sup>rd</sup> before the Tree Lighting.

**Kick off to Summer – June 3 at Horse Fair Park.** Committee assignments were reviewed. Banners will be ordered and members were given flyers to distribute and post at local businesses. Member Horvath is tightening up the food trucks, would like to offer variety but not have so many trucks that they cannot make it worth their time. It was agreed 5-6 touch-a-truck vehicles would be ideal and location was of them was discussed. Beach balls, leis and colorful flags will be the decorations. Resident Kristy Andrus provides suggestions about how the kickball tournament could be run and registration will be highlighted in upcoming newsletters. Member Horvath will get a trophy for the winning group.

**Other Business.** The next meeting of the committee will be on May 9, 2022 at 6:00 p.m.
