Council Chambers, Spring Grove, Illinois, August 8, 2022; a meeting of the Community Engagement Committee was held this date at 6:04 p.m., at the Municipal Centre, 7401 Meyer Road; Chairperson Mike Lee presiding.

**Call to Order.** The following committee members were present: Chairperson Mike Lee, Members Salli Renz, Helena Hernquist and Mike White – 4. Absent: Member Jamie Horvath - 1. Also present for the Village was Kelly Popelka, Deputy Clerk.

**Public Comment.** *Chairperson Mike Lee opened the meeting up for public comment.* Public comment was closed as there was no one in attendance.

**Approval of the July 11, 2022 Meeting Minutes.** Member White moved, seconded by Member Renz to approve the minutes as presented. On voice vote and all in favor, the motion carried.

**Discuss Farmers Market.** There has been a great response to the email sent out to the Farmers Market vendors for information to highlight them in the newsletter. While there was no donated produce at the July Farmers Market, the committee will try again in August and include an event volunteer sign up form at the table. It was discussed to actively seeking out produce vendors this year for next year's market. The commission agreed to keep the format and pricing the same for 2023, \$100 for the year, \$25 for single events.


**Discuss Oktoberfest.** Online interest in the event is growing. Chairperson Lee will confirm how many people in the band will be eating/drinking, we will keep track of what they eat and drink to be able to track our overall costs. Staff met with Bill and Tammy Linardos and confirmed the menu; they will use the entire counter area inside the pavilion for their food service and supply their own staff. All food and beverages will be cash only. It was determined not to sell popcorn given the menu provided and lack of a sport organizations having the volunteers to do it. Extra refuse and recycling totes and porta potties have been ordered. Staff will promote early sign up for Cabbage bowling. Member Hernquist believes she can find quite a few volunteers.

**Discuss Trunk or Treat.** Banners will go up after Oktoberfest.
