SEPTEMBER, 12, 2022

Council Chambers, Spring Grove, Illinois, September 12, 2022; a meeting of the Community Engagement Committee was held this date at 6:05 p.m., at the Municipal Centre, 7401 Meyer Road; Chairperson Mike Lee presiding.

**Call to Order.** The following committee members were present: Chairperson Mike Lee, Members Salli Renz, Helena Hernquist and Jamie Horvath – 4. Absent: Member Mike White - 1. Also present for the Village was Kelly Popelka, Deputy Clerk.

**Public Comment.** *Chairperson Mike Lee opened the meeting up for public comment.* Public comment was closed as there was no one in attendance.

**Approval of the August 8, 2022 Meeting Minutes.** Member Horvath moved, seconded by Member Renz to approve the minutes as presented. On voice vote and all in favor, the motion carried.

**Discuss Farmers Market.** While there was no donated produce again at the August Farmers Market, the committee will try again in September. Member Hernquist offered to chair the program next year. The commission agreed to increase pricing for 2023 to \$150 for the year and offering a discount to \$100 if they sign up before January 1st, the \$25 for single events will remain the same. Chairperson Lee will begin speaking with vendors at September's event about 2023 and handing out the sign-up forms. Will also work toward scheduling food trucks, coffee vendors, etc.

**Discuss Oktoberfest.** Banners around town are up. Online interest in the event continues to grow. Volunteers looking good with a couple more people needed for games. Will give the band food and beer tickets to be able to track our overall costs. Bill and Tammy Linardos will be selling water in addition to their food sales.

**Discuss Trunk or Treat.** Will begin advertising for trunkers in the e-news and send an email to last years trunkers, event will be rain or shine

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 6:48 p.m.
