**MEETING MINUTES OF THE PARKS COMMITTEE
OF THE VILLAGE OF SPRING GROVE
SEPTEMBER 27, 2022**

Council Chambers, Spring Grove, Illinois, September 27, 2022; a meeting of the Parks Committee was held this date at 6:47 p.m., at the Municipal Centre, 7401 Meyer Road, Chairperson McMahon presiding.

Call to Order. The following members were present: Chairperson Bob McMahon; and Members Mark Eisenberg, Katie Fitzgerald, Mike Gajewski, Mike Lee, Jeff Letzter and Pat Mazzanti – 7. Absent: None – 0. Also present for the Village were Bob Walczak, Building and Zoning Officer; Mike Frer, Public Works Supervisor; Charis Attermeier, Treasurer; and Kelly Popelka, Deputy Clerk.

New Business.

Discuss Hatchery Park Construction Update. The siding of the building has been completed and just needs to be painted. Discussion ensued regarding permanent fix options for the flat roof that is leaking.

Discuss Parks Vandalism. Hatchery Park, Wilmot Farms Park and Thelen Park have seen continued vandalism even with increased police patrols. A brief discussion was had about adding cameras and lights to the parks.

Discuss Main Street Park Improvement Plan. The park is currently staked out for the proposed placement of the pavilion. There is no start date determined yet. The bike rack has been ordered. Member Lee asked if they should look for an alternate location for next year's Farmers Market. Member Eisenberg did not think any phase of the construction should affect it.

Public Comment. *Chairperson McMahon then opened the meeting up for discussion by the public.* Public comment was closed as no one was in attendance.
