MEETING MINUTES OF THE PARKS COMMITTEE  
OF THE VILLAGE OF SPRING GROVE  
FEBRUARY 27, 2024

Council Chambers, Spring Grove, Illinois, February 27, 2024; a meeting of the Parks Committee was held this date at 6:51 p.m., at the Municipal Centre, 7401 Meyer Road, Chairperson McMahon presiding.

**Call to Order.** The following members were present: Chairperson Bob McMahon; Members Mark Eisenberg, Mike Lee, Jeff Letzter, and Pat Mazzanti – 5. Absent: Members Katie Fitzgerald and Mike Gajewski – 2. Also present for the Village were Tina Witt, Village Treasurer; Mike Niedzwiecki, Chief of Police; Bob Walczak, Building and Zoning Officer; Mike Frer, Public Works Supervisor; and Kelly Popelka, Village Clerk.

**New Business.**

**Discuss Field Use Agreements.** Chairperson McMahon outlined pricing and compared to neighboring communities. Discussion about porta potties. After discussion the Committee agreed the Field Use Agreements for Stateline Comets and Richmond Burton Baseball Association will remain as written.

**Discuss Springdale Trails Park installation.** Chairperson McMahon reported delivery of the playground equipment is expected the first week of April with Public Works installing the equipment. The Committee discussed cost and time involved with install. Staff has been communicating with Play Illinois to obtain all information available to help with the install.

**Discuss Hatchery Park Fines.** Chairperson McMahon proposed increasing the fines for parking without a village sticker or parking pass and for failure to pick up dog poop from \$25 to \$50 to justify a part-time seasonal maintenance employee for Hatchery Park who would also enforce those ordinances. The Committee was in favor of going forward with a proposed job description.

**Public Comment.** None.

**Other Business.** Chairperson McMahon looked for an update on the new key cards for the parks. Chief Niedzwiecki is waiting on power at Main Street Park to be able to code all the cards. Discussion about the system and proposed holders of back-up manual keys. Chairperson McMahon voiced his concern about youths driving ATV's in neighborhoods and parks.

There being no further business to discuss, Member Letzter moved, seconded by Member Mazzanti to adjourn the meeting at 7:27 p.m. On voice vote, the motion carried.
